CALL TO ORDER & ROLL CALL

2. MINUTE APPROVAL – JULY 20, 2020 SPECIAL MEETING

On motion by Commissioner McCallum, second by Commissioner Arteaga-Morris, the Commission approved the minutes of the July 20, 2020 special meeting.

3. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>

A. <u>CERTIFY POLICE DISPATCHER ELIGIBILITY LIST</u>

Secretary/Chief Examiner Palacios explained that the examination to establish an eligibility list for the classification of Police Sergeant was held on March 2, 2021. The testing was limited to employees currently employed as full-time police officers with the Grandview Police Department that met the position description minimum qualifications. One candidate was in attendance.

<u>Examination Parts and Weights</u>. The examination consisted of an oral board weighted at 100%. The candidate was scored on oral communication, interpersonal insight, judgment, decisiveness, delegation and control.

The total possible points a candidate could receive was 100. The applicant must have passed with a 70% or better test score. The one candidate passed.
