Each year, the City contracts with the Yakima Valley Conference of Governments to provide technical assistance to staff regarding planning and land use applications.

MAYOR

On January 12, 2021, Council approved Resolution No. 2021-01, authorizing the Mayor to sign the Technical Assistance Contract No. 010121GV with the Yakima Valley Conference of Governments (YVCOG) in the amount of \$5,000.

On July 13, 2021, Council approved Resolution No. 2021-31, authorizing the Mayor to sign the Technical Assistance Contract No. 010121GV Amendment #1 with the YVCOG in the amount of \$10,000.

ITEM COMMENTARY (Background, discussion, key points, recommendations, etc.) Please identify any or all impacts this proposed action would have on the City budget, personnel resources, and/or residents.

Due to the increased volume of land use applications being processed since July 2021, the City has nearly expended the amended contract amount of \$10,000. An additional seven (7) land use applications have been received. Staff recommends increasing the amended contract amount an additional \$20,000, bringing the total amount of the original contract to \$35,000.
