ITEM HISTORY (Previous council reviews, action related to this item, and other pertinent history)

When a developer divides property for the purpose of constructing residences, the developer must comply with the subdivision requirements of the Grandview Municipal Code (GMC). GMC Section 16.20.048 requires the developer to install new water and sewer mains, irrigation systems, streets with curb/gutter, sidewalks and street lighting.

ITEM COMMENTARY (Background, discussion, key points, recommendations, etc.) Please identify any or all impacts this proposed action would have on the City budget, personnel resources, and/or residents.

This year, a developer challenged the street lighting requirement. GMC 16.28.080 states that the "lights shall be installed with the initial capital cost at the City's expense." In order to clarify the requirement, staff recommends Council amend GMC Section 16.28.080 to clearly identify that the developer is responsible for the entire cost of installing all new street lights for any new residential subdivision.

Street Lights shall be installed with the initial capital cost at the eity's developer's expense in conformance with the following standards:

- A. One street light at each intersection;

Once the development is approved by the city as complete, the city shall assume ownership including financial and maintenance responsibilities for the street lights.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON, AMENDING GRANDVIEW MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 16.28.080 STREET LIGHTING

WHEREAS, for ease of administrative enforcement of design standards for residential development, it is the intent of this amendment to provide clarification of street lighting installation,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Grandview Municipal Code Section 16.28.080 Street Lighting, which reads as follows:

16.28.080 Street Lighting

Street lights shall be installed with the initial capital cost at the city's expense in conformance with the following standards:

- A. One street light at each intersection;
- B. One street light at midblock if the block is longer than 450 feet; and
- C. Placement of street lights along arterial and collector streets shall conform to the city's design and construction standards and specifications for public works improvements.

Is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.28.080 Street Lighting

Street lights shall be installed with the initial capital cost at the city's developer's expense in conformance with the following standards:

- A. One street light at each intersection;
- B. One street light at midblock if the block is longer than 450 feet; and
- C. Placement of street lights along arterial and collector streets shall conform to the city's design and construction standards and specifications for public works improvements.

Once the development is approved by the city as complete, the city shall assume ownership including financial and maintenance responsibilities for the street lights.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 5 days after its passage and publication as required by law.

ITEM HISTORY (Previous council reviews, action related to this item, and other pertinent history)

In 1998, the City purchased a 1977 used boom truck from military surplus for approximately \$500. This vehicle has been used in numerous departments whenever there was a need to lift a heavy pump/motor for maintenance purposes. This year, the truck started having numerous maintenance related problems and now parts are not available. The unit is also considered unsafe, obsolete and needs to be replaced.

ITEM COMMENTARY (Background, discussion, key points, recommendations, etc.) Please identify any or all impacts this proposed action would have on the city budget, personnel resources, and/or residents.

To purchase a new boom truck, similar to this unit, would cost approximately \$250,000. Staff has located a used 2009 Freightliner M2 auger/crane in Oregon with approximately 32,000 miles and 1,300 running hours on the PTO system. This truck was available for purchase earlier in the year at a price of \$59,995. Council approved a budget amendment in June which appropriated \$60,000 for the purchase of this unit. The truck is currently on sale and the price has been reduced to \$34,995, which is well under what Council approved.

To purchase this used vehicle, Council must approve a resolution to waive the State's bidding requirements as per RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) when the "purchases involving special facilities or market conditions." The resolution must include information regarding the used vehicle such as mileage, vehicle condition and vehicle price.

Attached is an email from the State Auditor supporting the purchase utilizing this RCW process.

Re: Bidding Requirements

A couple of months ago, I reported that our boom truck is beyond repair and is considered unsafe. Council then approved a budget amendment of \$60,000 for the purchase of a used unit to replace our old unsafe truck

I understand the bidding process, but I was a little unclear on the "Special Facilities and Market Condition" provision until we received the email from our auditor.

In order for us to use the special provisions in RCW 39.04.280 (1) (b) we must first exercise the following:

- We need to identify a vehicle.
- We must include the sale price, mileage, and the vehicle's condition.
- We must have City Council approve a Resolution authorizing staff to by-pass the state's bidding requirements and authorize staff to purchase a used vehicle.

We have located is a 2009 Freightliner M2 Auger/Crane with 32,000 miles and 1,300 hours on the PTO system for a price of \$34,995, in Portland, Oregon. The dealership is having the unit inspected and when Anita returns, we can prepare the Resolution to submit to Council for consideration. We will include this memorandum, the email from the auditor, the inspection report, and a copy of the RCW as part of the informational packet.

A new truck like this one would cost around \$250,000 and having the ability to use the RCW saves us a lot of money and most importantly provides us with a very much needed piece of equipment.

Hi Matt,

The purchase of a used vehicle can be made using the special facilities and market conditions exemptions per RCW 39.04.280(1)(b). Special market conditions would be limited to good deals on used cars. Competitive bidding procedures may be waived by adopting a resolution at the time of purchase or adopting written policies beforehand. If by resolution, it must state the factual basis for the exception. If by written policy, the contract and factual basis for the exception must be recorded and open to public inspection.

Hi Matt,

The City is able to shop local dealers for vehicles, however, would have to follow procurement requirements applicable. For the City, the bidding requirement for purchases over \$15K would require the formal competitive bidding process if the City were to purchase a new vehicle. If the City were to look for a used vehicle, the City can claim a sole source exemption on the vehicle. A quick note on that as well, any used vehicles with the full factory warranty should be considered as new.

RCW 39.04.280 Competitive bidding requirements—Exemptions. This section provides uniform exemptions to competitive bidding requirements utilized by municipalities when awarding contracts for public works and contracts for purchases. The statutes governing a specific type of municipality may also include other exemptions from competitive bidding requirements. The purpose of this section is to supplement and not to limit the current powers of any municipality to provide exemptions from competitive bidding requirements.

(1) Competitive bidding requirements may be waived by the

governing body of the municipality for:

(a) Purchases that are clearly and legitimately limited to a single source of supply;

(b) Purchases involving special facilities or market conditions;

(c) Purchases in the event of an emergency;

(d) Purchases of insurance or bonds; and

(e) Public works in the event of an emergency.

(2)(a) The waiver of competitive bidding requirements under subsection (1) of this section may be by resolution or by the terms of written policies adopted by the municipality, at the option of the governing body of the municipality. If the governing body elects to waive competitive bidding requirements by the terms of written policies adopted by the municipality, immediately after the award of any contract, the contract and the factual basis for the exception must be recorded and open to public inspection.

If a resolution is adopted by a governing body to waive competitive bidding requirements under (b) of this subsection, the resolution must recite the factual basis for the exception. This subsection (2)(a) does not apply in the event of an emergency.

- (b) If an emergency exists, the person or persons designated by the governing body of the municipality to act in the event of an emergency may declare an emergency situation exists, waive competitive bidding requirements, and award all necessary contracts on behalf of the municipality to address the emergency situation. If a contract is awarded without competitive bidding due to an emergency, a written finding of the existence of an emergency must be made by the governing body or its designee and duly entered of record no later than two weeks following the award of the contract.
- (3) For purposes of this section "emergency" means unforeseen circumstances beyond the control of the municipality that either: (a) Present a real, immediate threat to the proper performance of essential functions; or (b) will likely result in material loss or damage to property, bodily injury, or loss of life if immediate action is not taken. [1998 c 278 § 1.]

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, WASHINGTON, WAIVING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE BID LAW TO ALLOW A PURCHASE INVOLVING SPECIAL FACILITIES OR MARKET CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, the City currently owns a 1977 used boom truck that was purchased in 1998 through military surplus; and,

WHEREAS, said boom truck is having maintenance issues and parts are unavailable for repairs; and,

WHEREAS, said boom truck has outlived is useful life and is considered unsafe, obsolete and needs to be replaced; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council previously amended the budget to allocate \$60,000 towards the purchase of a replacement boom truck; and

WHEREAS, upon investigation, City staff have determined that the cost of purchasing a new boom truck is likely to exceed \$250,000; and,

WHEREAS, City staff have located a used 2009 Freightliner M2 Auger/Crane with approximately 32,000 miles and 1,300 running hours on the PTO system for sale in the amount of \$34,995; and,

WHEREAS, RCW 39.04.280(1)(b) provides an exception to the state bidding requirements for purchases that involve special facilities or market conditions; and

WHEREAS, for reasons set forth above, including the unique market conditions relating to the purchase of new and used boom trucks, the City Council has determined it to be in the best interest of the City and its residents to waive the competitive bid requirements pursuant to RCW 39.04.280(1)(b); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, AS FOLLOWS:
