

FENCES

- All fences require a permit.
- Any fence constructed that is 6 foot or over requires a special use permit.
- A fence must be no closer than 30 feet from an intersection of two streets or an alley. (See Diagrams on the back of this page)
- Corner lots must have 30 feet on either side of the corner intersection along street lines for traffic visibility. Except fences, walls or plantings that are 36 inches or less in height are allowed in the 30-foot visibility area.
- Fencing materials must be durable. Fences or walls may not be built from old (or new) tires, plywood, pallets, press board, cardboard, or chicken wire or other materials that may harbor mosquitoes, or rapidly deteriorate in the elements.


