Incident: Robbery / Residential Burglary x2

Location: 600 blk Highland Rd, Grandview, WA Date of Incident: 08/23/2023 Case Number: 23v4800

On 8/23/23 at 9:43 pm Grandview Police Officers were dispatched to the 600 blk of Highland Rd, Grandview, WA for a report of a burglary in progress. The suspect, described as a shorter, thin, male, wearing a tank top, dark shorts and a backpack, entered the victim's residence via the front door and stole several sets of keys. The suspect then tried to steal the victim's vehicle, however, the victims confronted the suspect, and an altercation took place. The suspect fled on foot.

A Grandview PD officer was in the area when the call was dispatched and was on scene within seconds of being dispatched. Officers set containment. Investigating officers located a second victim a few houses down, who advised the suspect had also entered their residence.

A Police K9 unit was requested, and the Kennewick Police Dept fulfilled the request and deployed their K9. Drones were deployed in an effort to locate the suspect. Officers tracked the suspect but were unable to locate him. During the track the K9 was able to locate an item that the suspect had been wearing. The item was collected as evidence and will be sent to the WSP crime lab for analysis.

Anyone in the area of Smith School with surveillance cameras is asked to check their cameras between the hours of 9 pm and 11:30 pm on 8/23/23. If anyone matching the description is observed on camera, please contact the Grandview Police Department at 509 882 2000.
